



## **ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME RULES**

### **ELIGIBILITY**

Scholarships are open to students currently in *3ème* and *4ème* Secondaire of the Belgian State Education System. This corresponds to Grades 9 and 10 in the US system.

### **SCHOLARSHIP OFFERING**

St. John's International School is offering 2 academic scholarships and 1 sports scholarship.

### **PROGRAMME ENTRY**

Successful scholarship applicants will enter Grade 10 or 11, which corresponds to the year before or the first year of the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) at St. John's. Sport's scholar should take the IBDP in Physical Education.

### **AWARD CRITERIA**

Scholarships will be awarded based on academic merit and potential, with particular emphasis on the student's academic achievements, abilities, and predicted outcomes in the IBDP.

### **FEE REDUCTION**

Scholarships will offer a fee reduction up to 100%. The specific fee reduction will

depend on the student's predicted academic performance at the end of the IBDP.

### **PROGRAMME COMMITMENT**

Scholarship recipients are required to complete the IBDP programme at St. John's. The scholarship will remain valid for the entire duration of the two or three years of study for the IBDP, contingent upon maintaining the required academic performance.

Students awarded with the academic scholarship are expected to take full part in school life, namely in Model United Nations or in Maths Olympiads, and more widely in extracurriculars aligned with their skills and capacity.

Students awarded with the sports scholarship are expected to take full part in school life, namely in school, national and international tournaments and in extracurriculars aligned with their skills and capacity.

### **INELIGIBILITY FOR EXCHANGE PROGRAMMES**

Scholarship recipients are not eligible to participate in any Inspired exchange programmes during the duration of their scholarship.

### **EXCLUSIONS FROM FEE REDUCTION**

The scholarship fee reduction does not cover additional costs, such as overnight trips, extracurricular activities, or the costs associated with sitting examinations.

### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

All applicants must submit a completed scholarship application form along with the required supporting documents of two years of school reports, any awards achieved in the last two years and two reference letters from academic settings. ### **SELECTION PROCESS**

Applicants are required to submit the following documents:

- 2023-24 academic record
- 2025-26 academic record

- Personal statement
- 2 reference letters
- Scholarship means test form

The selection committee will review all applications and conduct the following with shortlisted candidates:

- CAT 4 test
- Exams in Higher Level subjects selected
- Interview
- Audition on sports (only for Sports scholar)

The committee's decision is final and not subject to appeal.

### **ONGOING PERFORMANCE AND REVIEW**

Scholarship recipients must maintain a high academic standard throughout their studies in preparation for the IBDP. The scholarship may be reviewed annually based on academic performance, and failure to meet the required standards could result in the reduction or withdrawal of the scholarship.

### **BEHAVIOURAL EXPECTATIONS**

Scholarship recipients are expected to uphold the values and behavioural standards of St. John's. Any disciplinary issues may result in the revocation of the scholarship.

### **TRANSFERABILITY OF THE SCHOLARSHIP**

The scholarship is non-transferable and cannot be applied to siblings or other family members.

### **HEALTH AND SAFETY REQUIREMENTS**

Scholarship students must meet all health and safety requirements set by the school, including submitting medical records and undergoing health assessments if required.

## COMMUNICATION OF RESULTS

Applicants will be notified of the scholarship results by April 30<sup>th</sup> 2026.

## TERMINATION OF SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship may be terminated if the recipient voluntarily withdraws from the school or is dismissed due to academic or behavioural issues. In such cases, any remaining fees will be due, and no further fee reductions will apply.
