The school is an IB Continuum school offering the PYP, MYP and DP programmes. Students work towards the International Baccalaureate Diploma which is awarded upon successful completion of requirements set by the IB organization. All graduating students are awarded a High School Diploma. Students not pursuing the full IB Diploma work towards either an Academic Diploma or a General Diploma.



Because of the nature of our transient population, the GPA is an average of all courses taken at St John's during the Junior year only.




