Welcome and Orientation morning for all new students and their families

All new parents are invited to the Visual and Performing Arts Centre (VPAC) for a welcome and introduction to the St. John's community by our Head of School Mr David Brooke.

Parent Welcome Coffee

All parents are invited to join the Welcome Committee on Tuesday 29 August immediately following drop off for a casual coffee morning. Details will be communicated closer to the date.

Green & White Day

Join the entire St John's community for Green & White Day on Saturday, 26 August. There will be food, sports, music and theater activities for all ages. Community organizations will also have information booths to introduce families to the variety of services and programs available in the greater Waterloo community.

Welcome Soirée

A cocktail evening for all new parents and adults, hosted by the Welcome Committee on Friday 15 September. Babysitting will be provided for new families. You will be receiving an invitation in August with details.

Additionally, the Welcome Committee hosts a variety of events throughout the school year. Information is included in the Friday newsletters.

FAMILY SUPPORT PROGRAMME

The Family Support programme is a group of parent volunteers who help those who have experienced unexpected hardships. EVENTS ORGANIZED BY THE LION'S PRIDE

The Lion's Pride organises events throughout the year, and you will be kept well informed when they are approaching. We encourage every family to attend these events.

INTERNATIONAL FESTIVAL

This is a major event within the St. John's community that occurs each year. Most countries have a nationality stand that is organised by the parents of that country. These are decorated with belongings and artifacts that represent their nation.

On International Day, children arrive dressed in their national costume or an outfit that represents their country. In the afternoon, children from Early Learning School, Primary and Middle School are guided around the stands to learn about the different countries. In the evening, a parade is held with children walking behind their national flag (parents are also encouraged to participate). This is an opportunity for the children to show pride in their origins. The parade is then followed by food sampling. The evening is one huge social and taste-filled experience. For this part of the evening, each country is asked to supply food that is from their nation. WINTER SOIRÉE

Similar to the Welcome Soirée, this cocktail event is designed to welcome new parents and adults who have joined the St. John's community after the beginning of the school year, and on this occasion, many existing families will also attend.

FAMILY DAY

A school fête with a difference held annually in the spring. This is a great day with such a variety of activities that will entertain the whole family. Food and drink is also available. There are a variety of novelty stalls that have the whole family entertained for hours. Last year, we had pony rides to jumping castles to the bottle booth. There is something for the whole family. This is a fun family event so please come along and join in the festivities.

SCHOLASTIC BOOK SALES

The Scholastic Committee facilitates the sales of books written in English for Pre-K– Grade 8 up to five times a school year. Flyers are sent home through the students, parents order and pay online, and the books are delivered to school where they are distributed to the students.

SCHOOL LIBRARY

The St. John's libraries are available for all family members. The school library is located on A level in a newly renovated space that will encourage a love of reading and literacy in all ages.

The Primary School sections contain a great collection of books and A/V materials. All Primary School students attend a weekly scheduled library lesson where they learn library and research skills, book appreciation and literacy. Parents are encouraged and welcome to become active participants in their child's literacy development. All parents have the opportunity to become a member of the Primary School Library and borrow books. Consider volunteering to help with the day-to-day running of the library. This is a great way to meet other families and to become involved in the St. John's community. The Primary School Library offers a high level of service, which is only achieved with the generous assistance provided by the many volunteers.

There is an online library of carefully selected reference databases. The online catalogue, Destiny, features WebPath Express which is a resource designed to help students find appropriate and authoritative resources. Please visit our MHS library blog, The Library Connection, which can be found at Library Connection blog (password is stjohs) where you can connect to all our online library resources, access links to Middle and High School Recommended Reading Lists, students book reviews and recommended websites. The Library Team work with the Middle and High school faculty, and play a central role in facilitating reading for pleasure, inquiry and research. Parents are welcome to browse and borrow from our collections and use the wireless network connection. Volunteers are always welcome in the MHS Library; the work they do is highly valued as we serve our community of learners.

Our library is open daily Monday to Thursday, 8.15am – 4.30pm and Friday, 8.15am – 4.00pm.

SUMMER CAMPS

Summer camps for children of all ages are organised on the St John's campus by school staff. These camps include Sports, Arts and Language. Further details will be provided as the year progresses, but please contact campdirector@stjohns.be for more information.

INCLEMENT WEATHER ANNOUNCEMENTS

During winter, the Head of School, with the advice of the bus company, will decide if a snow day closure is necessary. When weather or other circumstances force us to close school for a day, you will receive an SMS (message) on your mobile phone.

LOST AND FOUND

Missing items can be found in the Lost and Found cupboard located in the Primary School on the shelves on A level in the old Primary School lobby, Middle School lobby and the main Gym Foyer. It is a good idea to label all your child's belongings.

EARLY LEARNING & PRIMARY SCHOOL

Each child in Grades 1–5 will receive an agenda. This includes all the school rules, dress requirements and important dates. As this agenda has to be checked each day by parents, you will become very familiar with this document.

NO NUTS PLEASE

We have some students at the school who suffer from a potentially fatal allergy to nuts. Please ensure that your children have a nutfree snack and lunches.

DOGS

St. John's is a dog-free school. No dogs on campus, please.

TAKE HOME FOLDERS

Please check your child's folder each week as information pertaining to events and your child's academic programme is communicated via this folder. Folders should be returned to school each week.

BACK-TO-SCHOOL NIGHT

At the beginning of the school year, all parents are invited to a presentation at which teachers are introduced, the curriculum is presented and questions are answered. You are encouraged to attend this informative evening. You will receive information regarding the dates, times, and venues of the Back-to-School Nights.

PARENT-TEACHER-STUDENT REPORTING SYSTEM

Teachers will send home a “settling-in” report at the end of September/early October. There are two parent-teacher-student conferences held each year; in October and February. There will also be school reports at the end of Semesters 1 and 2.

STUDENT-LED PORTFOLIO CONFERENCE

This is scheduled in Spring; the child presents their “portfolio” during a one hour session featuring their academic achievements over the year. Children really enjoy this very special interaction where they have everyone’s undivided attention.

“CLASSES DE PLEIN AIR” / RESIDENTIAL FIELD TRIPS

All Grade 3, 4 and 5 students take an extended trip with their grade and their teachers. These trips usually last for several nights and are designed to enrich lessons and study units. These trips form part of the school curriculum and are highly recommended. Cost is included in tuition fees.

FIELD TRIPS

Field trips are planned at all grade levels to enhance class lessons and to link in with the units of inquiry. At the start of the year, parents sign one permission slip for field trips for the entire year in the agenda book. If you would like to join your child on the class outing you can let the homeroom parent know that you are interested in serving as a chaperone.

PARTIES

Each classroom has homeroom parents who coordinate volunteers to organize parties for the students at Christmas, Carnival, Easter and other holidays as appropriate. Please remember to bring nut free items to the class parties and any necessary cutlery/crockery.

HOT LUNCHES

A hot lunch is served each day in Primary School. Students may choose between a packed lunch from home or hot lunch options. A vegetarian option is offered each day. Monthly menus are emailed home and are posted on the St John’s International School Portal. Hot lunches are managed by the company Sodexo. Through the app “So Happy” by Sodexo, parents will be able to put money in the student account which will be deducted when the student chooses to have a hot lunch. Instructions on how to set up the student account will be given at the beginning of the school year.

COLD LUNCHES

All lunches brought from home must be consumable without the need for microwaving. Cold lunches should include ready-to-eat items. Good quality thermos containers can provide a warm alternative. Food sealed in a thermos will be approved as long as the child can open the container safely. Please consider healthy options for packed lunches.

SWIMMING PROGRAMME

Swimming is part of the curriculum. The children in Grades 1-5 participate in the swimming programme all year round. The PE Department coordinates this programme. Children are bussed to and from the swimming pool. Speedo-style swimsuit and swim cap are required. Further information/schedule will be sent home at the start of the school year.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

All children from Grades 1–5 are required to wear the school uniform. If you would like to order your school uniforms online, please follow this link: www.schoolblazer.com Uniforms can be ordered throughout the year. In Primary School, students must wear shoes that comply with the uniform policy, which are to be leather in black, brown, grey or navy blue. Inside shoes may be requested during winter months (these may be slippers, but closed shoes and in uniform colours). In mild weather, sandals in uniform colours with back straps are allowed. Shoes may be purchased anywhere.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Sports, Art, Music, Drama—all these extra-curricular classes take place after school hours. For more information, see the St. John's MySchool Portal.

DAY CARE

For our youngest students, from 12 months old. Day Care is part of our Early Learning School. Please contact Admissions (admissions@stjohns.be) for more information.

TIMBERTOTS

Children from 2 years old participate in the Timbertots programme. This is a full-day programme but please enquire with Admissions (admissions@stjohns.be) if you require more flexible drop-off or pick up.

CUB CARE

A Garderie/Child Care service is available on regular school days from 3.30pm – 6.00pm. This service is to help families who require assistance while parents are working longer hours. Registration for the Cub Care garderie is via our Early Learning and Primary School secretary, Mrs Jo Taylor; jtaylor@stjohns.be, Contact number: 0474 96 1868.

Each student in the Middle/High School receives an agenda (school diary) in which all the rules, regulations, dress code and important dates are clearly presented.

If your child would like to stay at school after 3.45pm, they should be either registered for an after school activity or for supervised study, which happens everyday from 3.45pm – 5.00pm on C level. The campus is open until 7.00pm for Middle and High School students. Between 5.00pm and 7.00pm Middle and High School students should be based in the Sports Hall Foyer once their other activities have finished.

NO NUTS PLEASE

We have some students at the school who suffer from a potentially fatal allergy to nuts. Please ensure that your children have a nut-free snack and lunches.

DOGS

St. John's is a dog-free school. No dogs on campus, please.

CAFETERIA LUNCHES

Each student is issued with a school ID card at the beginning of the school year, after the school photo is taken. This card is also the “lunch card.” Vegetarian options are available each day.

BACK-TO-SCHOOL NIGHT

At the beginning of the school year, all parents are invited to a presentation at which teachers are introduced, curriculum is presented and questions answered. You are encouraged to attend this informative evening.

PARENT-TEACHER-STUDENT CONFERENCES

The first conference takes place in October and is an opportunity to meet with each of your child's teachers. Each teacher is given 5 minutes to discuss your child's progress. You will be given the opportunity to reserve your meeting times. The second conference, in February, reflects on the student's learning and sets goals for the remainder of the year. Students are expected to attend the conferences with their parents.

SPORTS

Cross-Country, Soccer, Volleyball, Basketball, Swimming, Baseball, Softball, Tennis and Track and Field are offered as interscholastic sports. Try-outs take place at the beginning of the season.

Autumn: Cross-Country, Soccer, Volleyball

Winter: Basketball, Swimming, Rugby 7's

Spring: Baseball, Golf, Softball, Tennis, Track and Field

If a student is chosen for a St. John's team, they will have competitions throughout Europe (France, Germany, Holland and England). Each player and another team member are often housed with a host family when travelling overnight to away competitions. When teams visit St. John's, parents are expected to reciprocate and host opposition players.

ACTIVITY NIGHT

Activity Night at St. John's is only for Middle School students (Grades 6-8). This is an evening with games, videos and dancing under close supervision. Held several times a year, parents are called on as volunteers to sell snacks and refreshments. It's great fun and very well organized by the Middle School teachers. Usual times are from 6.30pm to 9.00pm.

CHOIR/HONOR CHOIR/DANCE

If your child enjoys the Performing Arts, St. John's offers many opportunities. Students have the opportunity to sign up at the beginning of the school year. Performances and auditions will be advertised.

DRAMA

The school seems to abound with talent. The productions are of an excellent standard.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Sports, Art, Music, Drama – all these extra-curricular classes take place after school hours. For more information, see the St. John's MySchool Portal.

MEDIEVAL DAY

Students in Grade 6 arrive at school dressed for Medieval Day. Parents are always needed. On this occasion, students learn all about medieval crafts, music and gastronomic delights. This event takes place towards the end of the school year and parents help with the décor, assist teachers and serve lunch.

SCHOOL TRIPS

In addition to educational day trips, Middle School students also have a wonderful school field trips. These trips generally take place for the whole week and costs are included in the standard tuition fees. A meeting prior to each trip is organized for parents to familiarize themselves with the itinerary and various activities.

ACADEMIC NIGHT

Held in February or March, this event concerns parents of Grade 9 and 10 students. The International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme is presented in detail by the academic team. It is highly advisable to attend. Parents whose children are not taking the full IB DP might also find this useful as experience shows that most US colleges give credits for IB DP subjects, and it is a useful tool to have when making college applications.

COLLEGE NIGHTS

Grade 12 College Night for students and their parents to review the upcoming year and look specifically at applications for the UK and the US which have centralized application systems.

“Brussels College Night” is an event sponsored by the American Fulbright Association. It is a fair attended by representatives from over 100 colleges and universities, mostly from the US, to give information to parents and students in one-on-one discussions. It is strongly advised to attend this event, especially for Grade 11 and 12 students who are planning to attend college in the US or the UK. It is a big event!

Grade 11 College Night is when we introduce Grade 11 students and their parents to the college application process. After that, we begin individual meetings with students and parents. This event will be held in January.

STANDARDISED TESTS

For those not familiar with the US, SATs (Scholastic Achievement Tests) and the ACT (American College Testing) are tests required for entry to US colleges. While St. John's offers preliminary tests PSAT through the school, the SATs and the ACT are each student's responsibility. These tests take place several times during the school year, and students can find all the information at www.collegeboard.com or www.act.org

Students in Grades 6 to 10 complete the MAP Standardised Testing annually.

ADVANCE PLACEMENT (AP) TESTS

These exams are most relevant to US-bound college applicants but are also taken by a number of Grade 11 students applying to UL or other universities to show the level they have already reached in certain subjects. The school offers a selection of AP subjects and many full IB DP students take these as an option. Students taking calculus receive instruction to take the AP exam in Grade 11. AP exams are offered in Economics, Calculus, French, German and Spanish as a foreign language.

THE VISUAL AND PERFORMING ARTS

St. John's believes that Art and Design, Dance, Drama and Music are essential components of human life. In an international school like St. John's, with a diverse student body from different cultural backgrounds, the arts become the language of all students.

The arts play an integral part in the growth and development of the individual, in communicating across cultural borders and in creating a sense of involvement and belonging.

The purpose of the Visual and Performing Arts programme at St. John's is to enable students to realize their creative and imaginative potential while developing critical awareness, an understanding of the fundamental elements in each subject area and a wide range of technical skills in relation to different media and approaches.

A full schedule of exhibitions by visiting artists and students in the school gallery, student theatrical productions, artistic performances and musical concerts, along with many organized cultural trips, supplement and enrich the many programmes.

PROM

Grade 11 students take the lead with organizing and fund-raising for this event. At the beginning of the academic year, a group of parents, Grade 11 students and teachers form a committee. Prom is usually held at an external venue in or around Brussels. However, before the event, the grade 11 and 12 students and their parents and teachers gather in Timbertops Early Learning School for a cocktail. Weather permitting, drinks are offered in the garden. If you have a Grade 11 or 12 student you are warmly invite to this prom reception which typically takes place in late May or early June.

GRADUATION

A wonderful and emotional celebration in June that signifies the completion of High School for Grade 12 students, their families and friends. The ceremony combines presentations from the Head of School, High School Principal, students and a guest speaker. There are also musical performances. Each student is recognized for their achievements.

GRADUATION DINNER

This event follows the graduation ceremony and is attended by family and friends of the graduating students.

ANIMAL CARE

Having a pet while living in Belgium does not have to be problematic. Belgians are very caring towards pets.

Dogs are permitted in almost all public places as well as some hotels. Some grocery stores have a “no pet” sign hanging in the window; however, you will still see small dogs in a handbag or basket. It is, however, recommended that you always have a leash on hand. In most parks, dogs have to be on a leash. This is also a requirement for insurance purposes. Some towns impose fines on dog owners who do not clean up after their dogs. Most veterinarians have an open clinic during the week that does not require an appointment. These hours will vary with each clinic. They will also have an emergency after-hours number.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

If you are traveling from Brussels to Waterloo, you catch the TEC bus from Gare du Midi. You can buy your ticket online, on the SELF vending machine, at POINTS TEC (bookshops, convenience stores, petrol stations using contactless payment) or from the driver. These buses come every half an hour. The trip takes about 40 minutes and you need to get off on the corner of Chaussée de Bruxelles and Drève Richelle and walk 20 minutes east on Drève Richelle to the school.

The other option is the train that leaves from Gare du Midi to Waterloo station. This is about a 40-minute walk from the station to St John's School, or a taxi ride.

On trams, buses and metro the following people can ride for free:

Children under 6 years of age accompanied by a passenger of 12 years of age or older carrying a valid travel document (maximum 4 children).

Children from 6 to 12 years of age accompanied by a person of 12 years of age or older carrying a valid travel document, on condition that they travel after 09.00 on week days (maximum 4 children).

Children under 12 years of age with a 'large family reduction card'. Only valid in second class.

Employees of companies that have an agreement with NMBS to pay 80% of the rail pass. The government pays the remaining 20%.

Journalists travel free in second class.

SECURITY FOR CHILDREN AND TEENAGERS

Security in Belgium is no worse than in any other city and in Waterloo our children are fairly sheltered. Belgian police do keep a look-out for children/teenagers and are generally very kind to them – even bringing them back home in a police car if they are lost or found walking the streets alone at night.

As in any country, children must be watched and should not be allowed to wander off on their own. Having said that, in general Belgium is one of the best places in which to bring up your child.

There are a few pointers, which you should be aware of:

Alcohol

The minimum age for drinking beer and unfortified wines is 16. The age for drinking spirits is 18. Bars who serve underage drinkers are very heavily fined, but this does not stop them. Alcohol is freely sold in all supermarkets. They should not be sold to underage drinkers but identity cards are seldom asked for.

Babysitters

St John's keeps a list of high school students who do babysitting. The list should be available at Reception from early September.

Cell Phones / MP3 Players

Your children or teenagers should keep any expensive electronics discreetly in their possession.

Driving

Your teenager might have their driving license, but if they are under the age of 17 they may not drive at all. If they are 17 and a provision is made at the commune, they may drive accompanied by an experienced driver but may not carry unlicensed passengers, nor may they drive on weekend nights after 10.00pm. The same rules apply to 18 year old drivers in possession of a provisional license. If they are caught breaking these laws, they will lose their license and will not be insured. ID Cards

All children over the age of 12 have to be in possession of an ID card. They can be obtained at your local commune. The law states that you should be in possession of your ID card at all times.

Illegal Substances

St John's has an excellent drug awareness programme for students from middle school onwards. The school has a zero-tolerance policy towards any narcotic drug.

Public Transport

If you live near a public transport facility, buses and trains are generally considered safe but children and teenagers should not be left alone at an empty station. At night, it is advisable for teenagers to travel in a group.

Tobacco

It is illegal to sell cigarettes to anyone under the age of 16 years old. It is illegal to smoke in any public building including restaurants.
